adverb

: prior to a specified or implied past, present, or future time : by this time : PREVIOUSLY <he had already left when I called> 2 —used as an intensive <all right already><enough already>

al·though:

conjunction

in spite of the fact that : <even though you warned me, I touched the hot plate anyway>

an·i·mal

noun

any of a kingdom (Animalia) of living things including many-celled organisms and often many of the single-celled ones (as protozoans) that typically differ from plants in having cells without cellulose walls, in lacking chlorophyll and the capacity for photosynthesis, in requiring more complex food materials (as proteins), in being organized to a greater degree of complexity, and in having the capacity for spontaneous movement and rapid motor responses to stimulation <The animal had a beautiful fur coat>

ask

verb

to call on for an answer <she asked him about his trip> **b:** to put a question about <asking her whereabouts> **c:** SPEAK, UTTER <ask a question> 2 **a:** to make a request of <she asked her teacher for help> **b:** to make a request for <she asked help from her teacher>

ba·by

noun

an extremely young child; especially : INFANT (2): an extremely young animal <The baby cried all night long>

ball

noun

a round or roundish body or mass: as **a:** a spherical or ovoid body used in a game or sport <a tennis ball>

base

noun

the lower part of a wall, pier, or column considered as a separate architectural feature (2): the lower part of a complete architectural design **b:** the bottom of something considered as its support : FOUNDATION <The wall was wider at its base than at the top>

beau·ti·ful

adjective

having qualities of **beauty** : exciting aesthetic pleasure 2 : generally pleasing <It is such a beautiful day, I can't wait to go outside>

bed*noun*

a piece of furniture on or in which to lie and sleep <I'm tired and going to *bed* early>

be·gin*verb*

to do the first part of an action : go into the first part of a process : **START** <Ready, *begin!*>

be·side*preposition*

by the side of <walk *beside* me>

bird*noun*

any of a class (Aves) of warm-blooded vertebrates distinguished by having the body more or less completely covered with feathers and the forelimbs modified as wings

blue*adjective*

of the color blue; low in spirits : **MELANCHOLY**

b: marked by low spirits : **DEPRESSING** <a *blue* funk> <things looked *blue*>

boat*noun*

: a small vessel for travel on water **b: SHIP**
<We had a small row *boat* at our lake house>

bot·tom*noun*

the underside of something **b:** a surface (as the seat of a chair) designed to support something resting on it —used figuratively in phrases like *the bottom dropped out* to describe a sudden collapse or downturn <Jed lost millions when the *bottom* dropped out of the stock market> **c:** the posterior end of the trunk

bright*adjective*

radiating or reflecting light : **SHINING**, **SPARKLING** <*bright* lights> <*bright* eyes>

b: **SUNNY** <a *bright* day>; *also* : radiant with happiness <*bright* smiling faces> <*bright* moments>

bring*verb*

to convey, lead, carry, or cause to come along with one toward the place from which the action is being regarded <Could you bring my purse to me?>

build*verb*

form by ordering and uniting materials by gradual means into a composite whole
: **CONSTRUCT** <Sam was hired to build a new fence around the yard>

busi·ness*noun*

purposeful activity a: **ROLE, FUNCTION** <how the human mind went about its *business* of learning — H. A. Overstreet> **b:** an immediate task or objective : **MISSION** <what is your *business* here> **c:** a particular field of endeavor <the best in the *business*>³ a: a usually commercial or mercantile activity engaged in as a means of livelihood :

buy*verb*

to acquire possession, ownership, or rights to the use or services of by payment especially of money : **PURCHASE**² a: to obtain in exchange for something often at a sacrifice <I am going to *buy* strawberries for dinner>

care*noun*

suffering of mind : **GRIEF**² a: a disquieted state of mixed uncertainty, apprehension, and responsibility **b:** a cause for such anxiety <My mother gave me a lot of *care* when I had the flu>

care·ful·ly*adverb*

exercising or taking care: marked by attentive concern and solicitude **b:** marked by wary caution or prudence <Sally carefully cleaned her bedroom>



car·ry*verb*

to move while supporting : **TRANSPORT** <her legs refused to *carry* her further — Ellen Glasgow>2: to convey by direct communication <*carry* tales about a friend>

cases*noun*

a set of circumstances or conditions <is the statement true in all three *cases*> **b** (1): a situation requiring investigation or action (as by the police) (2): the object of investigation or consideration

catch*verb*

to capture or seize especially after pursuit <*catch* a thief> **b**: to take or entangle in or as if in a snare <The fishermen were able to *catch* fish in a net>

cen·ter*noun*

: a point, area, person, or thing that is most important or pivotal in relation to an indicated activity, interest, or condition <a railroad *center*> <the *center* of the controversy>

check*noun*

exposure of a chess king to an attack from which he must be protected or moved to <With that move, I put your king in *check*>

child*noun*

an unborn or recently born person <the *child* cried throughout the night>

choose*verb*

to select freely and after consideration <*choose* a career>

cir·cle*noun*

a closed plane curve every point of which is equidistant from a fixed point within the curve <Sue was able to draw a perfect *circle*, freehand>

clear*adjective*

BRIGHT, LUMINOUS b: CLOUDLESS; *specifically* : less than one-tenth covered <a *clear* sky> **c**: free from mist, haze, or dust <a *clear* day> **d: UNTROUBLED, SERENE** <a *clear* gaze>

col·or*noun*

a phenomenon of light (as red, brown, pink, or gray) or visual perception that enables one to differentiate otherwise identical objects, <Red is my favorite *color*>

cor·rect*transitive verb*

to make or set right : **AMEND** <*correct* an error>

dark*adjective*

devoid or partially devoid of light : not receiving, reflecting, transmitting, or radiating light <a *dark* room> **b**: transmitting only a portion of light <*dark* glasses>2 **a**: wholly or partially black <*dark* clothing>

deep*adjective*

extending far from some surface or area: as **a**: extending far downward <a *deep* well> **b** (1): extending well inward from an outer surface <a *deep* gash> <a *deep*-chested animal>

dif·fer·ence*noun*

the quality or state of being **different** <the *difference* between right and wrong>



dis·tance*noun*

separation in time **b**: the degree or amount of separation between two points, lines, surfaces, or objects **c** (1): an extent of area or an advance along a route measured linearly (2): an extent of space measured other than linearly <within walking *distance*> **d**

dry*adjective*

free or relatively free from a liquid and especially water **b**: not being in or under water <*dry land*> **c**: lacking precipitation or humidity <a *dry climate*>

easy*adjective*

causing or involving little difficulty or discomfort <within *easy reach*> **b**: requiring or indicating little effort, thought, or reflection <*easy clichés*>

ei·ther*adjective*

being the one and the other of two : **EACH** <flowers blooming on *either* side of the walk> <plays *either* instrument well> **2** : being the one or the other of two <take *either* road>

else*adverb*

in a different manner or place or at a different time <how *else* could he have acted> <here and nowhere *else*> **b**: in an additional manner or place or at an additional time <where *else* is gold found>

en·er·gy *noun*

dynamic quality <narrative *energy*> **b**: the capacity of acting or being active <intellectual *energy*> **c**: a usually positive spiritual force <the *energy* flowing through all people> **2**: vigorous exertion of power : **EFFORT** <investing time and *energy*>

ev·ery·one: every person : **EVERYBODY****ev·ery·thing**

all that exists **b**: all that relates to the subject **2**: all that is important <you mean *everything* to me> **3**: all sorts of other things — used to indicate related but unspecified events, facts, or conditions <all the pains and colds and *everything*>

ex·cept *preposition*

with the exclusion or **exception** of <daily *except* Sundays>

ex·plain *verb*

to make known <*explain* the secret of your success> **b**: to make plain or understandable <footnotes that *explain* the terms> **2**: to give the reason for or cause of <unable to *explain* his strange conduct> **3**: to show the logical development or relationships of <*explained* the new theory>

eye *noun*

a specialized light-sensitive sensory structure of animals that in nearly all vertebrates, most arthropods, and some mollusks is the image-forming organ of sight; *especially* : the nearly spherical usually paired hollow organ of sight in vertebrates that is filled with a jellylike material, is lined with a photosensitive retina, and is lodged in a bony orbit in the skull

fact *noun*

the quality of being actual : **ACTUALITY** <a question of *fact* hinges on evidence> **4** a: something that has actual existence <space exploration is now a *fact*> **b**: an actual occurrence <prove the *fact* of damage> **5**: a piece of information presented as having objective reality

fall *verb*

to descend freely by the force of gravity **b**: to hang freely <her hair *falls* over her shoulders> **c**: to drop oneself to a lower position <*fell* to his knees> **d**: to come or go as if by falling <darkness *falls* early in the winter>



fa·mous *adjective*

widely known **b**: honored for achievement2: **EXCELLENT, FIRST-RATE**
<*famous* weather for a walk>

farm *noun*

a plot of land devoted to the raising of animals and especially domestic livestock

fell *verb*

to descend freely by the force of gravity **b**: to hang freely <her hair *falls* over her shoulders>

field *noun*

an open land area free of woods and buildings (2): an area of land marked by the presence of particular objects or features <dune *fields*> **b** (1): an area of cleared enclosed land used for cultivation or pasture <a *field* of wheat>

fig·ure *noun*

geometric form (as a line, triangle, or sphere) especially when considered as a set of geometric elements (as points) in space of a given number of dimensions <a square is a plane *figure*>

fi·nal·ly *adverb*

coming at the end : being the last in a series, process, or progress <Halloween finally arrived>

floor *noun*

the level base of a room2 a: the lower inside surface of a hollow structure (as a cave or bodily part) **b**: a ground surface <the ocean *floor*>

fly *verb*

to move in or pass through the air with wings **b**: to move through the air or before the wind or through outer space <a bird or a bat can fly>

fol·low *verb*

to go, proceed, or come after <*followed* the guide>2 a: to engage in as a calling or way of life : **PURSUE** <wheat-growing is generally *followed* here> **b**: to walk or proceed along <*follow* a path>

foot *noun*

the terminal part of the vertebrate leg upon which an individual stands <my foot is being pinched in my shoe>

free *adjective*

having the legal and political rights of a citizen **b**: enjoying civil and political liberty <*free* citizens>

friend

noun

one attached to another by affection or esteem **b**: **ACQUAINTANCE**2 a: one that is not hostile **b**: one that is of the same nation, party, or group3: one that favors or promotes something (as a charity)4: a favored companion <my *friend* is always kind to me>

fun *noun*

what provides amusement or enjoyment; *specifically* : playful often boisterous action or speech <full of *fun*>

game *noun*

activity engaged in for diversion or amusement : **PLAY** (2): the equipment for a game **b**: often derisive or mocking jesting : **FUN, SPORT** <make *game* of a nervous player>

girl

noun

a female child from birth to adulthood **b**: **DAUGHTER** **c**: a young unmarried woman <the *girl* won the math competition>

glass

noun

any of various amorphous materials formed from a melt by cooling to rigidity without crystallization: <The window was made of *glass*>

gold

noun

a yellow malleable ductile metallic element that occurs chiefly free or in a few minerals and is used especially in coins, jewelry, and dentures — see <*gold* doubloons filled the treasure box>



gone*adjective*LOST, RUINED <lost looks and *gone* faculties —**gov·ern·ment***noun*the organization, machinery, or agency through which a political unit exercises authority and performs functions and which is usually classified according to the distribution of power within it <this November we will re-organize our *government* by holding an election>**grass***noun*herbage suitable or used for grazing animals²: any of a large family (Gramineae syn. Poaceae) of monocotyledonous mostly herbaceous plants with jointed stems, slender sheathing leaves, and flowers borne in spikelets <keep off the *grass*> <the horse had never won on *grass*>**grew***verb**past of GROW* <The child *grew* up to be a mathematician>**hair***noun*a slender threadlike outgrowth of the epidermis of an animal; *especially* : one of the usually pigmented filaments that form the characteristic coat of a mammal **b**: the hairy covering of an animal or a body part; *especially* : the coating of hairs on a human head <I brush my *hair* every morning>**hap·pened***intransitive verb*to occur by chance —often used with *it*<it so *happened* I went your way home from school>**hap·py***adjective*favored by luck or fortune : FORTUNATE <a *happy* coincidence>²: notably fitting, effective, or well adapted : FELICITOUS <a *happy* choice>**heart***noun*a hollow muscular organ of vertebrate animals that by its rhythmic contraction acts as a force pump maintaining the circulation of the blood <I exercise to make my *heart* stronger>**heat***noun*a condition of being hot : WARMTH (2): a marked or notable degree of hotness<the *heat* can become unbearable in the summer>**heavy***adjective*having great weight; *also* : characterized by mass or weight <how *heavy* is it?>**held***past and past participle of HOLD* <the boy and girl *held* hands at the movies>**his·to·ry***noun*a chronological record of significant events (as affecting a nation or institution) often including an explanation of their causes <High school students study American *History*>**hour***noun*the 24th part of a day : 60 minutes³ **a**: the time of day reckoned in two 12-hour periods <I will give you one *hour* to complete the test>**hu·man***adjective*of, relating to, or characteristic of **humans**²: consisting of **humans**³ **a**: having human form or attributes **b**: susceptible to or representative of the sympathies and frailties of human nature <to err is *human*, to forgive divine>

ice*noun*

frozen water **b**: a sheet or stretch of ice **2**: a substance resembling ice; *especially* : the solid state of a substance usually found as a gas or liquid <ammonia *ice* in the rings of Saturn>

in·for·ma·tion*noun*

: knowledge obtained from investigation, study, or instruction <students acquire a lot of *information* at school>

in·stead *adverb*

as a substitute or equivalent <was going to write but called *instead*> **2** : as an alternative to something expressed or implied : **RATHER** <longed *instead* for a quiet country life>

iron*noun*

a silver-white malleable ductile magnetic heavy metallic element that readily rusts in moist air, occurs native in meteorites and combined in most igneous rocks, is the most used of metals, and is vital to biological processes <the ancient spear was made of *iron*>

itself*pronoun*

that identical one — compare **IT** 1 —used reflexively <watched the cat giving *itself* a bath>

job*noun*

a piece of work; *especially* : a small miscellaneous piece of work undertaken on order at a stated rate **b**: the object or material on which work is being done **c**: something produced by or as if by work <did a nice *job*>

lan·guage *noun*

the words, their pronunciation, and the methods of combining them used and understood by a community <French is the *language* spoken by the inhabitants of France>

late*adjective*

coming or remaining after the due, usual, or proper time <a *late* spring>

lay*verb*

to put or set down <*lay* your books on the table>

b: to place for rest or sleep;

least*adjective*

lowest in importance or position **2 a**: smallest in size or degree <Kate was the *least* likely to steal the cookies>

leave*verb*

to put, deposit, or deliver before or in the process of departing <Please *leave* a message>

length*noun*

the longer or longest dimension of an object **b**: a measured distance or dimension <10 feet in *length*>

lis·ten*verb*

to pay attention to sound <*listen* to music>

lon·ger*adjective*

having greater length than usual <the spelling list is *longer* in the 6th grade than in the 5th>

lost*adjective*

not made use of, won, or claimed **2 a**: no longer possessed <the poor little kittens *lost* their mittens>



lot*noun*

a portion of land **b**: a measured parcel of land having fixed boundaries and designated on a plot or survey **c**: a motion-picture studio and its adjoining property **d**: an establishment for the storage or sale of motor vehicles <a used car *lot*>

low *adjective*

having a small upward extension or elevation <a *low* wall>

ma·chine*noun*

a mechanically, electrically, or electronically operated device for performing a task **g**: a coin-operated device <a hay-making *machine*>

main*adjective*

CHIEF, PRINCIPAL <the *main* idea>

map*noun*

a representation usually on a flat surface of the whole or a part of an area **b**: a representation of the celestial sphere or a part of it <before we went hiking, we took a *map* of the trail>

mark*noun*

a conspicuous object serving as a guide for travelers (2): something (as a line, notch, or fixed object) designed to record position<I carved a notch in the tree to *mark* our path>

may·be*adverb*

PERHAPS <*Maybe* we'll go to the ice cream shop after school today>

mea·sure*verb*

to allot or apportion in **measured** amounts <*measure* out three cups>

mid·dle*adjective*

equally distant from the extremes : **MEDIAL, CENTRAL** <the *middle* house in the row>

milk*noun*

a fluid secreted by the mammary glands of females for the nourishment of their young;<Kids should drink *milk* every day>

mind*noun*

the element or complex of elements in an individual that feels, perceives, thinks, wills, and especially reasons <The mind is a precious thing to waste>

miss*verb*

to fail to hit, reach, or contact <*miss* the target>

mod·ern*adjective*

of, relating to, or characteristic of a period extending from a relevant remote past to the present time<the woman's dress was very *modern*>

mo·ment*noun*

a minute portion or point of time<I'll be ready to go in just one *moment*>

moon*noun*

often capitalized : the earth's natural satellite that shines by the sun's reflected light,<the *moon* shone through my bedroom window>

moun·tain*noun*

a landmass that projects conspicuously above its surroundings and is higher than a hill<the *mountain* was visible from many miles away>

mouth*noun*

the natural opening through which food passes into the body of an animal and which in vertebrates is typically bounded externally by the lips and internally by the pharynx and encloses the tongue, gums, and teeth<you must open your *mouth* for the dentist to look at your teeth



music*noun*

the science or art of ordering tones or sounds in succession, in combination, and in temporal relationships to produce a composition having unity and continuity<her voice was *music* to my ears>

nat·u·ral*adjective*

being in accordance with or determined by **nature** <the forest was in it's *natural* state>

north*adverb*

to, toward, or in the north<we drove to go to Canada>

ocean*noun*

the whole body of salt water that covers nearly three fourths of the surface of the earth **b**: any of the large bodies of water (as the Atlantic Ocean) into which the great ocean is divided<the *ocean* teemed with fish>

oil*noun*

any of numerous unctuous combustible substances that are liquid or can be liquefied easily on warming, are soluble in ether but not in water, and leave a greasy stain on paper or cloth **b** (1): **PETROLEUM** <*Oil* provides fuel for our automobiles>

out·side*noun*

a place or region beyond an enclosure or boundary: as (1): the world beyond the confines of an institution (as a prison)<We went *outside* to play>

past*adjective*

just gone or elapsed <for the *past* few months>

pat·tern*noun*

something designed or used as a model for making things <a dressmaker's *pattern*>

pay*verb*

to make due return to for services rendered or property delivered **b**: to engage for money : **HIRE** <you couldn't *pay* me to do that>

plan*noun*

a method for achieving an end<the *plan* for climbing the tree involved a ladder>

plane*noun*

an airplane designed to be able to reach low earth orbit <We traveled by *plane* to Michigan for summer vacation>

poor*adjective*

lacking material possessions **b**: of, relating to, or characterized by poverty<the man was *poor* because he lost his job>

pos·si·ble*adjective*

being within the limits of ability, capacity, or realization <a *possible* but difficult task>

pow·er*noun*

ability to act or produce an effect (2): ability to get extra-base hits<the batter was a *power* hitter>

pres·ent*noun*

GIFT <My birthday *present* was a new bike>

prob·lem*noun*

proposition in mathematics or physics stating something to be done<the math *problem* was difficult to solve>

ques·tion*noun*

an interrogative expression often used to test knowledge<the *question* on the test was inscrutable>



quite*adverb***WHOLLY, COMPLETELY** <not *quite* finished>**rain***noun*water falling in drops condensed from vapor in the atmosphere<during the monsoon, huge quantities of *rain* fell>**rath·er***adverb*with better reason or more propriety : more properly <this you should pity *rather* than despise>**reach***verb*to touch or grasp by extending a part of the body (as a hand) or an object <couldn't *reach* the apple>**reading***noun*an indication of a certain state of affairs <a study to get some *reading* of shoppers' preferences>**re·al***adjective*not artificial, fraudulent, or illusory : **GENUINE** <*real* gold>;**rea·son***noun*a statement offered in explanation or justification <gave a *reason* that was quite satisfactory>**road***noun*an open way for vehicles, persons, and animals<the truck drove down the middle of the *road*>**rock***noun*a large mass of stone forming a cliff, promontory, or peak<the *rock* formed an impenetrable wall>**round***adjective*having every part of the surface or circumference equidistant from the center (2): **CYLINDRICAL** <a *round* peg> **b**: approximately round <a *round* face>**sat***past and past participle of SIT*<The teacher *sat* at her desk>**seem***intransitive verb*to appear to the observation or understanding<it would *seem* that the movie is over>**sent***past and past participle of SEND*<The letter was *sent* in the mail yesterday>**sev·en***noun*the **seventh** in a set or series <the *seven* of clubs>**shell***noun*a hard rigid usually largely calcareous covering or support of an animal **b**: the hard or tough often thin outer covering of an egg (as of a bird or reptile)<The egg *shell* cracked when I dropped the egg>**ship***noun*a large seagoing vessel<the *ship* stood at port>**sim·ple***adjective*free from ostentation or display <a *simple* outfit>3: of humble origin or modest position <a *simple* farmer>**sin·gle***adjective*unaccompanied by others : **LONE, SOLE** <the *single* survivor of the disaster>

size*noun*

one of a series of graduated measures especially of manufactured articles (as of clothing) conventionally identified by numbers or letters <a *size* seven hat>

sky*noun*

the upper atmosphere or expanse of space that constitutes an apparent great vault or arch over the earth<the *sky* was a beautiful blue>

sleep*noun*

the natural periodic suspension of consciousness during which the powers of the body are restored<if kids don't get enough *sleep*, they have difficulty in school>

snow*noun*

precipitation in the form of small white ice crystals formed directly from the water vapor of the air at a temperature of less than 32°F (0°C) **b** (1): a descent or shower of snow crystals (2): a mass of fallen snow crystals<we had a lot of *snow* this winter>

soil*noun*

the upper layer of earth that may be dug or plowed and in which plants grow<the *soil* was fertile so the wheat grew quickly>

some•one*pronoun*

some person : **SOMEBODY** <*Someone* call the kids in for dinner!>

speak*verb*

to utter words or articulate sounds with the ordinary voice <we taught our dog to *speak* using cookies>

speed*noun*

the act or state of moving swiftly<the airplane flew with great *speed*>

spring*verb*

to issue with speed and force or as a stream <tears *spring* from our eyes>

square*noun*

a rectangle with all four sides equal<all four sides of the *square* measured 4 inches>

stay*verb*

to continue in a place or condition : **REMAIN** <*stay* put till I come back>

step*noun*

one of a series of structures consisting of a riser and a <the *step* on the porch was loose>

store*noun*

a business establishment where usually diversified goods are kept for retail sale <a grocery *store*>

straight*adjective*

free from curves, bends, angles, or irregularities <*straight* hair> <*straight* timber>

strange*adjective*

not before known, heard, or seen<the new coat looked *strange* on the woman>

street*noun*

a thoroughfare especially in a city, town, or village that is wider than an alley or lane and that usually includes sidewalks<lives on a fashionable *street*>

sud•den•ly*adverb*

happening or coming unexpectedly<the lightning flashed *suddenly*>



sum·mer*noun*

the season between spring and autumn comprising in the northern hemisphere usually the months of June, July, and August or as reckoned astronomically extending from the June solstice to the September equinox <*summer vacation is my favorite time of the year*>

sup·pose*verb*

to lay down tentatively as a hypothesis, assumption, or proposal <*suppose a fire broke out*> <*suppose you bring the salad*>

sys·tem*noun*

a regularly interacting or interdependent group of items forming a unified whole <a number *system*>

tall*adjective*

of a specified height <five feet *tall*>

teach·er*noun*

one that **teaches**; <my *teacher* is fair and helpful>

them·selves*pronoun plural*

their normal, healthy, or sane condition <were *themselves* again after a night's rest>

third*adjective*

being next after the second in place or time <the *third* taxi in line>

thus*adverb*

in this or that manner or way <described it *thus*>

ti·ny*adjective*

very small or diminutive <the bug was so *tiny* it could barely be seen>

trav·el*verb*

to go on or as if on a trip or tour <we are going to *travel* to Oregon at spring break.>

trip*verb*

to catch the foot against something so as to stumble <Jake stuck out his foot so Mark would *trip*>

trouble*noun*

public unrest or disturbance <there's *trouble* brewing downtown>

un·der·stand*verb*

to grasp the meaning of <*understand* Russian>

walked*verb*

to move along on foot : advance by steps <Jane *walked* to school every day>

war*noun*

a state of usually open and declared armed hostile conflict between states or nations <the government has declared *war* on hunger in the United States>

warm*adjective*

having or giving out heat to a moderate or adequate degree <*warm* weather> <a *warm* fire>

watch*verb*

to be attentive or vigilant <I will *watch* over the baby while you go to the store>

weath·er*noun*

the state of the atmosphere with respect to heat or cold, wetness or dryness, calm or storm, clearness or cloudiness <The *weather* in summer is usually hot and dry>



week*noun*

any of a series of 7-day cycles used in various calendars; *especially* : a 7-day cycle beginning on Sunday and ending on Saturday <in one *week* we will go on vacation>

whose*pronoun*

that which belongs to whom <*Whose* woods these are, I think I know>

wide*adjective*

having great extent : **VAST** <a *wide* area>

wild*adjective*

living in a state of nature and not ordinarily tame or domesticated <*wild* ducks>

win·dow*noun*

an opening especially in the wall of a building for admission of light and air that is usually closed by casements or sashes containing transparent material (as glass) and capable of being opened and shut <when I looked out the *window*, I saw it was raining>

win·ter*noun*

the season between autumn and spring comprising in the northern hemisphere usually the months of December, January, and February or as reckoned astronomically extending from the December solstice to the March equinox <This past *winter* was very harsh>

wish*verb*

to have a desire for (as something unattainable) <I *wish* I could have a pony>

within*preposition*

not beyond the quantity, degree, or limitations of <live *within* your income>

wom·an*noun*

an adult female person <the *woman* wore a blue dress and matching shoes>

wood*noun*

the hard fibrous substance consisting basically of xylem that makes up the greater part of the stems, branches, and roots of trees or shrubs beneath the bark and is found to a limited extent in herbaceous plants <the desk was made of *wood*>

wrote

past and dialect past participle of WRITE <I *wrote* my friend a letter>

your·self*pronoun*

that identical one that is you —used reflexively <you might hurt *yourself*>,
