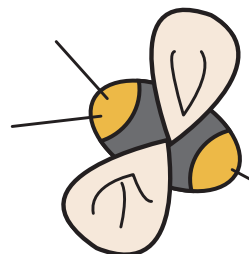
Okay, now that you've signed up:
